Year 2 Head Out to the Forest....

All of the children in Year 2 will be taking part in a 6 week outdoor-learning program during the spring term.

The children will be working in the local community forest of Glapton Woods to explore the local woodland.

We will spend each Wednesday afternoon exploring the local flora and fauna in the woods.



Alongside these studies

the children will be learning valuable team work and communication skills which will enable them to be more effective learners when back in the classroom. It promises to be a very exciting time for the children!

What the children will need....

The children will need to attend school each Wednesday morning in their normal uniform. However, at the start of the afternoon they need to change into suitable clothing for outdoor learning.

clothes. Track suits, comfortable trousers and warm jumpers are essential. The children will also need a change in footwear. A sturdy trainer, walking boot or wellington would be ideal.

Due to the unpredictable nature of the British weather, I would also advise a

waterproof coat!
