In **Maths** we will be linking our **Science** work on Rocks, & examining & analysing volcano statistics, rock temperatures and changing forms as well as animal and fossil dating. Later, we will be studying Skeletons & how we move. This will involve some measuring and investigation. We will learn more about the role of archaeologists and palaeontologists. Hopefully, this will give us an insight into the animals and humans that roamed the earth in prehistoric times.

Through **History & Geography** we will deepen our understanding of timelines and changes in Britain, from hunter-gatherers to early farmers. From this we will look at bread making, evaluating and recreating our own bread through **Design and Technology**.

In **French** we will continue to build upon our language skills and also looking at cave art in France. In **Art** we will look at early drawings, paintings and communications using natural materials, such as clay. Plus, we'll be studying modern day graffiti street art such as the work of street artist 'Banksy'.

P.E. will be Swimming on Monday, & Gymnastics on Thursday - with some scientific twists! **Music** will explore arrangements in the class orchestra and discover how the Stone Age people made music. In **Computing** we will use programming skills to create work related to our topic.



How you can help

There will still be reading, spellings and maths homework every week. Your child will write details in their diary on the day the homework is set. There could be follow-up research in other areas if appropriate.

Please check the diary regularly and encourage your child to complete the tasks set. Encourage your child to read regularly, and explain what they understand from the text. Please make sure your child has their **swimming kit and P.E. kit** (black shorts, white tee-shirt and trainers or plimsolls) in school on **Mondays**. PE kit should stay in school all week.

Your child also needs a **painting apron/old shirt** in school to protect their uniform during art lessons. This should also remain on their in their PE bag all week.
