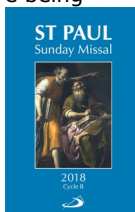

### For the sick and housebound in our parishes

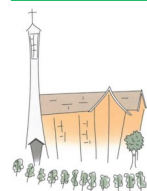
