Following on from this item in last week's newsletter; what kind of duties does your parish priest carry out which could be done by parishioners? Cash counting and handling. In Our Lady & St Patrick's this is now the responsibility of just one parishioner. Prudent management would be to train up more people to help with this task. In Clifton there are teams who do the cash counting, but Fr Philip is almost exclusively the one who takes the money to be banked. We could do with more cash counters, and two or three people to take on the banking (this can be at the local Post Office.) Also we need to look for a new Gift-Aid co-ordinator, possibly a role that could be for both parishes. Our thanks to Christine Boott who does this work for us in Clifton at the present.
