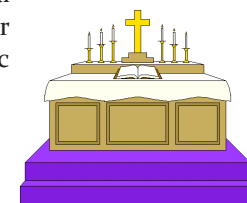


Dear Brothers and Sisters,

We often hear before a Mass starts an intention is offered, and see in our parish newsletters an intention is printed for each Mass. What does it mean to have a Mass intention offered for someone or a sending of a mass card? We don't often talk about it. The Mass is the greatest prayer of the church that we have. Each Mass makes present for us the one sacrifice of Jesus Christ which He offered to the Father for our salvation.

When a priest offers a Holy Mass he has three intentions: First, to offer the Mass reverently and validly in accord with the norms of the Catholic Church. Second, to offer the Mass in union with the whole Church and for the good of the whole Church. Third, to offer the Mass for a particular intention, and it is this intention that is referred to when people speak of a 'Mass Intention', namely, the specific intention for which the priest celebrant offers the Mass: The priest's intention specifies the "special fruit" (*Pope Pius VI, Auctorem Fidei (1786)*) for which that particular Mass is being offered. Given this understanding an individual asks a priest to offer Mass 'for' several reasons for example; in thanksgiving, for the intentions of another person (such as on a birthday, Wedding Anniversary, Ordination anniversary), or, for the repose of the soul of someone who has died or on their anniversary of death. According to an ancient custom of the Church, people can make an offering to a priest, asking him to apply the special fruit of the Mass for their intention. Having a Mass offered for a particular intention is a wonderful part of our Catholic identity.
