Our vigil is prayerful, peaceful, and non-judgmental.

We are seeking volunteers to pray with us during Lent (Ash Wednesday 6th March – Palm Sunday 14th April), between 6am and 6pm, on a rota basis, near the Treatment Centre on the QMC campus, where many abortions in Nottinghamshire take place.
